## Surfacing on A143 Beccles Road Bradwell

Work is due to take place Monday 13 October 2025 to resurface the carriageway of A143 Beccles Road for a duration of five nights. This work is expected to be completed by Saturday 18 October weather permitting. The scheme will improve the carriageway surface and is being carried out to help minimise disruption with overnight road closure in place.

Road closure is currently planned as follows: Carriageway resurfacing on A143 Beccles Road: From Monday 13 October to Saturday 18 October, (8pm – 5am).

When the road closure on A143 Beccles Road is in place, a fully signed diversion route will be in place. Drivers may also choose to use alternative roads, including non-A-roads, to complete their journeys while the closure is in effect.

Access to properties and businesses within the closures will be always maintained from one end of the closure however there may be times where vehicle access is restricted as work takes place in front of properties. Emergency services will be made aware of the closures.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this surfacing work is carried out.

The work which will cost in the region of £44,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Infrastructure Department and their contractors.
