Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO10195) affecting the Beccles Road from its junction with Pinecot Avenue for 505m north eastwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Bradwell to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 20:00 and 05:00 from 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 8<sup>th</sup> December 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Beccles Road, Western Bypass, A47 Gorleston On Sea J A143 Join N, A47 Gorleston On Sea From J B1370 To J A143 Including Roundabouts N, A47 Gorleston On Sea From J A143 To J A1243 Including Roundabout N, A47 Gorleston On Sea From J A1243 To J A143 S, A47 Gorleston On Sea From J A143 To J B1370 Excluding Roundabouts S, A47 Gorleston On Sea J A143 Leave S, Lowestoft Road, A47 Gorleston On Sea J B1370 Roundabout, A47 Gorleston On Sea From Dualling To J B1370 Including Roundabout, Beaufort Way.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 8<sup>th</sup> December 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
