

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO10471) affecting the Herringfleet Road from 100 metres south of its junction with Blocka Road for 365 metres southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Fritton with St. Olaves to facilitate pole testing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:30 and 15:30 on 26th January 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 9th March 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Herringfleet Road, Beccles Road, Beaufort Way, Road From Beaufort Way To Woodfarm Lane, Carrel Road, Jenner Road, Lowestoft Road, A47 Gorleston On Sea From Dualling To J B1370 Including Roundabout, A47 From Start Of Dualling At Gorleston On Sea To J B1375 Sw, A47 From J B1375 To End Of Dualling At Gorleston On Sea, Yarmouth Road, A47 J B1375 Roundabout, A47 From J B1375 To J B1385 S, A47 J B1385 Roundabout, Corton Long Lane, Millennium Way, Somerleyton Road, Oulton Street, Hall Lane, Flixton Road, Blundeston Road, The Street, St Olaves Road, Market Lane (Lowestoft, Somerleyton, Ashby and Herringfleet, Fritton and St. Olaves, Oulton, Corton, Lound, Bradwell, Belton with Browston, Flixton, Hopton-on-Sea, Blundeston).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: BT.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 9th March 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
